Facts About Saint Dominic



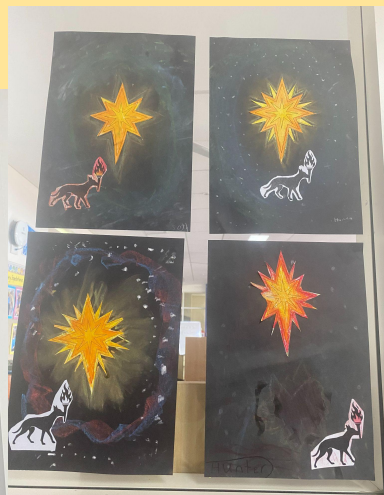

BIRTH & DEATH

St Carlos Acutis was born on the 3rd of May 1991 in London. Soon after he died on the 12th of October 2006. At only 15 years of age, Carlo was diagnosed with an untreatable leukaemia, and shortly passed after. Carlos was buried on the 6th of April 2019, at iglesia de Santa Maria Maggiore, Assisi, Italy.



WHAT ARE THE MIRACLES??

The two miracles recognised for the canonisation of St. Carlo Acutis are
 • the healing of a young boy in Brazil and a young woman in Costa Rica. The first involved a Brazilian boy named Matheus who was healed of a malformed pancreas after his family prayed to Acutis. The second was the recovery of a Costa Rican student from a severe head injury after her mother made a pilgrimage to his tomb.



BACKGROUND INFORMATION

St. Carlo Acutis was a modern-day Italian Catholic teenager known for his deep faith, love of technology, and efforts to spread religious knowledge through the internet.

Saint Carlo Acutis

Saint Carlo Acutis was the first ever Millennial saint, being born on the 3rd of May 1991 in London, to his parents [Antonio Salzano](#), [Andrea Acutis](#). As well as being the first Millennial saint, he is also the patron Saint of the internet because of his love for computers. Carlo sadly past away at the age of 15 on the 12th of October 2006 due to his leukaemia condition.

Family

Carlo's parents Andrea Acutis and Antonio Salzano, and his younger siblings, Michele and Francesca were not baptised or in the Catholic community. Carlo managed to convert his whole family to be Catholic leading his family to call him their 'little saviour' and their 'great educator in faith'. His father was an executive in the insurance industry and his mother's was working in the publishing industry. His two younger siblings were both born on the fourth anniversary of Carlo's passing which his parents thought to be miracle attributed to Carlo's intercession.

2. Despite his love for gaming, Saint Carlo limited his time to 1 hour a week to focus on his faith.

Miracle 1

He healed a Brazilian boy with a malformed pancreas after the boys mother prayed to Carlo to save him.

Miracle 2

He also healed a girl from Costa Rica who had a serious head injury from which the doctors thought she wouldn't recover, but the girls mother went to Carlo's to pray for her daughter from which she recovered.

The miracles Carlo Acutis performed led to his canonisation as a saint on October 7th 2025 by Pope Leo the XIV.
